



Cut paper to 3 x 6 inches. Use a decorative paper, magazine pages, newspaper, or gift wrap.

1. Fold paper in half vertically with pattern showing. Unfold.
2. Fold the two sides in to meet the center crease.
3. Turn up the bottom middle corners so that they meet the outer edge of the paper. You will now have two diagonal creases.
4. Turn up the bottom of the paper and fold over where the diagonal flaps end.
5. Pull the interior tip of the fold out to the side. Repeat on opposite side.
6. Tuck each corner back inside itself along the creased lines to form the shirt sleeves.
7. Flip the paper over. Fold the top edge down 1/4 inch.
8. Flip the paper over again. Fold the top two corners in towards the center about one centimeter from the top.
9. Lastly, fold up the bottom of the paper and tuck under the collar flaps.
